

Quartz Kitchen Worksurfaces



Luxore[®] is a stone surface made from pure natural quartz. Luxore[®] offers the natural beauty of quartz with up to six times the strength and durability of granite. Approximately 93% of Luxore[®] is mined quartz crystals, one of natures hardest materials. Quartz rates 7 out of 10 on Mohs Scale of Hardness. The only materials harder are Diamonds, Sapphire and Topaz. The Quartz crystals are used to create a beautiful and strong surface that is highly scratch and impact resistant.

The quartz is combined with special resins and pigment to produce a stone without high maintenance.

Luxore[®] is nonporous preventing unwelcome germs, bacteria and mildew. Luxore[®] is also scratch and stain resistant unlike alternative surface options such as marble etc.

Luxore[®] offers flexibility to make any vision a reality. Available in more than 26 colours and patterns delivering one of the strongest most durable surface materials on the market, without compromising on style.



BERMUDA DUSK



Care and Maintenance



Daily Cleaning

Luxore engineered quartz surfaces are very easy to maintain and with simple care, will retain its lustre and beauty for many years. For routine cleaning, use a soft cloth and soapy water. Once clean, rinse and dry the surface thoroughly.

Difficult Stains

Even though Luxore resists permanent staining when exposed to liquids such as wine, vinegar, tea and lemon juice wipe up spills as soon as possible.

For stubborn or dried on spills use the *Whitehall Luxury Worksurface Cleaning Kit.*



Heat Resistance

Although Luxore is heat resistant it is not heat proof, it is and can still be subject to potential and permanent damage when exposed to sudden and intense thermal shock e.g. extremely hot pans being placed directly onto the surface.

For this reason we recommend the use of a heat shield or trivet.

Scratching

Luxore is also scratch resistant but not scratch proof. Therefore when using a knife always use a chopping board.
